#### **UPCOMING GALILEO HIGH ACCURACY SERVICE (HAS) TEST CAMPAIGN**

The Galileo High Accuracy Service is an open access and free of charge service, based on the provision of precise corrections transmitted by the Galileo E6 signal (E6-B, data component) from a subset of the Galileo satellites, enabling users to achieve improved ranging and positioning performance.

As of 18/05/2021, Galileo will start testing specific aspects of the HAS service and consequently modifications to the E6-B data component (without any impact on compliance with the published OS SIS ICD) may be observed by users equipped with a receiver that is capable of acquiring this signal and extracting its data content. This test campaign is an essential step towards the development of the HAS operational service (HAS Initial service declaration is planned for 2022).

As indicated in the [Galileo High Accuracy Service \(HAS\) Info Note](#), after the completion of the internal testing activities, the involvement of key stakeholders and interested parties is planned, enabling pioneer users to experiment with HAS-like products. During this phase, feedback gathered from users will be used to consolidate the service. Detailed information on the process to participate will be published shortly.
