GALILEO HIGH ACCURACY SERVICE (HAS) TEST CAMPAIGN

The Galileo High Accuracy Service is intended to be an open access and free of charge service, based on the provision of precise corrections transmitted by the Galileo E6 signal (E6-B, data component) from a subset of the Galileo satellites, improving positioning performance.

Following the successful completion of the demonstration phase (Phase 0) in 2021 and the first half of 2022, Galileo will engage in HAS initial service (Phase 1) validation activities as of CW27. These testing activities aim at supporting the initial operational service declaration and are planned to last until Q4 2022, and potentially beyond.

During this period, HAS data will be transmitted in compliance with the recently published [Galileo HAS SIS ICD](#). Interested users can experiment in view of the upcoming initial operational service declaration. However, due to the nature of the planned activities, temporary interruptions and variable performance in the broadcast HAS data may be observed.
